



**Discover Okinawa
A Tropical Japan**

Day 1: Tokyo / Ishigaki-Jima

Flight to Ishigaki in the morning. Pick-up the rental car at the airport.
Visits and meals at your convenience. Night at the hotel.

*Gateway to the islands of Yaeyama, the southernmost islands of Japan, **Ishigaki-Jima** has everything for a tropical paradise postcard: emerald sea, fabulous coral reefs, white sandy beaches and black pearl culture.*

Day 2: Ishigaki-Jima

Visits and meals at your convenience. Night at the hotel.

Visit Suggestions:

- **Kabira Bay**

The bay of Kabira is one of the most beautiful landscapes of the island with its white sand beach that plunges into an emerald sea from which emerges a string of islets. It is also one of the places where black pearls can be harvested.

- **Sukuji Beach**

Sukuji beach is a beautiful place for swimming, scuba diving or fishing; bright white sand and shallow waters that extend out to the sea for a long distance.

Day 3: Ishigaki-Jima

Participate in a 5 hour tour to discover nearby deserted islands. Ferry crossings to the desert islands (Phantom Island, Baras Island and Kohama Island). Enjoy half a day of snorkeling.

Afternoon and meal at your convenience on Kohama Jima and depart for Ishigaki in the evening. Night at the hotel

Its central geographical location in the archipelago has earned the island of Kohama the nickname "Yaeyama's navel". With its Sugar Road which passes straight through sugar cane fields, the island is endowed with singular landscapes.

Day 4: Ishigaki-Jima

Visits and meals at your convenience. Night at the hotel.

Visit Suggestions:

- **Miyara Donchi House**
Built in 1819, it is the only high-ranking samurai house left in Okinawa.
- **Torin-ji Temple**
This Buddhist temple of the Rinzai sect was built in 1614. The entrance is flanked by the statues of two kings, which represent the guardian deities of the island.
- **Ishigaki Limestone Caves**
These caves were naturally formed over a period of 200,000 years.

Day 5: Ishigaki-Jima / Naha

Return rental car to Ishigaki Airport. Flight to Naha.

Pick-up rental car at Naha Airport. Visits and meals at your convenience. Night at the hotel.

The hotel is equipped with a swimming pool, so you can enjoy it at your leisure.

*The capital of Okinawa, **Naha**. You can find some of the most beautiful beaches of Japan as well as a very special atmosphere, whether it be the plaintive song of the sanchin (a kind of three-string banjo) or unique foods different from the rest of Japan. Food is marked by seasonings such as "Shima Tougashii" (awamori, an alcohol made from rice, in which red pepper has soaked) that you will add to your dishes and goya, a bitter vegetable which could be the secret to the longevity and health of the islanders.*

Day 6: Naha

Visits and meals at your convenience. Night at the hotel.

Visit Suggestions for families with kids:

- **Churaumi Aquarium**
Created to showcase the incredible biodiversity of the Okinawan Archipelago.
- **Okinawa World**
Okinawa World is a theme park located in the southern part of the main island of Okinawa. Visitors can learn all about traditional Okinawa Island culture while having fun.
- **Gyokusendo Cave**
Only 35km southeast of Naha, this very large and beautiful limestone cave was only discovered in 1967

Day 7 : Naha / Tokyo

Return rental car to Naha Airport.
