

Izu Archipelago: Exotic Islands in your own back yard. Shikine-Jima

Day 1: Tokyo / Shikine-Jima

Depart from Tokyo for Shikine-Jima by ferry in the evening.

Stay the night on board and arrival at Shikine-Jima the next morning.

Visits and meals at your convenience.

Night in a minshuku (dinner included).

Far from the crowds of tourists, **Shikine-Jima** is a small island rich in natural scenery, bordered by creeks and beautiful beaches. The island can be visited on foot or by bicycle and is appreciated for its wooded trails and natural hot springs.

After arriving on the island in the morning, you can leave your luggage at your accommodation and then set off to discover the island. Dinner at a local restaurant and night at the minshuku.

Visit Suggestions:

• Beaches, Scuba Diving

Relax on one of the white sandy beaches overlooking the turquoise waters or indulge in a short session of snorkeling or scuba diving.

• Natural Hot Springs

The island boasts many natural hot springs for you to enjoy.

• Sunset at the Beach

In the evening, you can admire the sunset from one of the island's beaches.

Day 2: Shikine-Jima

Visit Suggestions:

Day 3: Shikine-Jima / Oshima

Breakfast and check-out. Transit from Shikine-Jima to Oshima by rapid ferry. Departure in the early afternoon. Visits and meals at your convenience. Night at the hotel (dinner available as an option)

Oshima is a small volcanic island south of Tokyo. The island was once a retreat for monks, and decorated meditation caves can still be found there today. In the heart of Oshima is Mount Mihara, an active volcano that is the source of several sites and various hot springs on the island.

Visit Suggestions:

• Tokyo Toritsu Oshima Zoo

• Local Hot Springs

Enjoy the indoor baths, some of which offer beautiful views of Mount Mihara on a clear day.

• Rent a Bicycle

Visit Suggestions:

Mount Mihara

There are two main hiking trails up and around Mount Mihara,

- Habu Port
- Kyujinnomaru Tei

Visitors can stroll through the garden of this old residence, enter the building and see its large traditional tatami rooms.

• Odoriko no Sato Museum

The museum was made into a ryokan and commemorates the odoriko (folk dancers) who were active in the Izu region in the 1900s.

• Fudeshima island

There is an observation point where one can enjoy beautiful coastal views and a small island called Fudeshima.
