



WINTER SPORTS IN NISEKO



Niseko is Japan's most popular winter sports resort. Known for its soft, light powder and average annual snowfall of more than 15m, Niseko is a popular destination for skiers around the world. In addition to miles of ski slopes, many ski resorts offer visitors the opportunity to explore off-piste skiing, a relatively rare attraction in most other ski resorts in Japan.

Day 1: Tokyo / Sapporo / Niseko

Departure from Haneda airport and fly to Shin-Chitose.

Limousine bus transfer from Shin-Chitose Airport to Niseko Hirafu (about 3h30)

***Niseko** is the largest ski area in Hokkaido with 4 interconnected resorts. These 4 resorts offer skiing and snowboarding opportunities for all levels. There are many other alternatives such as cross-country skiing, snowmobiling, rafting, ice climbing, snowshoeing as well as hot springs.*
