



EXTENSION: Yoron Island

Day 7: Naha / Yoron Jima

Depart for Yoron Jima by ferry with the car. Visits and meals at your convenience. Night at a Minshuku

Yoron Island is one of the Amami Islands and is part of the Amami Gunto quasi-national park. It is famous for its clear waters and water sports such as kayaking, diving and swimming.

Day 8: Yoron Jima

Scuba diving experience in the morning. You don't need to know how to swim to discover the coral reefs and brightly coloured tropical fish (about 3h). Afternoon and meals at your convenience. Night in a Minshuku.

- **Yoron Folk Village**
Created to preserve the ancestral lifestyle and traditions of the islanders. Here, one can find old houses that have been moved and restored as well as traditional everyday objects that will tell future generations and visitors what life on the island was like when it first began.
